<u>Direct delivery of beer and malt-based refreshment beverages:</u>

According to your *Agreement Relating to the Direct Sale and Delivery of British Columbia Manufactured Product – Brewery/Brewpub* and/or LDB policy, you can make direct sales to customers as provided in the table below:

¹ For sales where direct delivery is not permitted, products must be distributed through the LDB's Distribution Centres. Note that for kegs, the LDB's Distribution Centre only handles kegs that are 18 litres or smaller.

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² Due to special pricelists in effect and differences in tax application for sales to duty free stores, a BC brewery/brewpub cannot directly deliver product to a Duty Free Store without the LDB being involved in the transaction. Exceptions apply and not all breweries/brewpubs will be able to do this. ³ All BC breweries/brewpubs may direct deliver their listed products to BC Liquor Stores. In addition to this, they may direct deliver non-listed products via a special in-store program that allows an individual BC Liquor Store to uniquely offer beer products from local breweries that are not carried in other BC Liquor Stores. Local breweries must have an annual production volume of 100,000 hectolitres or less to be eligible for this program.
